Event Overview

The Yuvamanthan Model United Nations (MUN) simulated real UN committees, centering around COP '28 (UNFCCC) and addressing climate action, global warming, and sustainable development. In the Conference of Parties Committee simulation, 18 delegates from various department portrayed diverse countries, fostering a dynamic international discourse. The All India Political Parties Meet (AIPPM) added a national perspective, featuring ministers and political leaders from across the country. Within this framework, 15 participants from various department assumed roles as ministers and heads of state/political parties, representing various Indian regions. Their discussions primarily focused on formulating India's Agenda to address pressing environmental issues. Overall, the Yuvamanthan MUN served as a platform for nuanced discussions, bridging global and national perspectives on critical environmental challenges.

Pre-Event Preparation:

- 1. Registration: Delegates registered on the Yuvamanthan website with assigned Teacher Coordinators.
- 2. Secretariat: A dedicated team of 5-10 student coordinators managed the event.
- 3. Committee Roles: Press Corps and Executive Board roles were assigned, including journalist, photographer, caricaturist, chairperson, vice-chairperson, rapporteur, and judges.
- 4. Research: In-depth research covered news, current affairs, policies, politics, economic/safety/environmental scenarios, and previous solutions.
- 5. Requirements: Event details, committee assignments, portfolios, notepad/document needs, room allocations, placards, and General Speaker's List (GSL) were determined.

Event-Day Proceedings:

- 1. Roll Call: Attendance was taken for voting procedures, document discussions, motions, and delegate attentiveness.
- 2. Speeches: General Speakers List featured opening speeches based on the agenda, followed by moderated caucus speeches on specific subtopics.
- 3. Discussions: Un-moderated caucus allowed informal/formal discussions on the agenda to decide motions and this time was also to be utilized by the students to write a Press Release of the Discussions that happened in the duration of the Event.
- 4. Points: Delegates raised Information, Order, Inquiry, and Personal Privilege points. The delegates were also allowed to exercise the right to reply.
- 5. Press Release: A combined press release proposed specific actions/policies, created and voted on by all the delegates in the duration of the Event.
