- Madam has urged all the students to respect the women and give her freedom as it is her basic right. Get enough knowledge about the women empowerment and help her.




Figure 1- Felicitation to the Guest Speaker by Dr. Shivkumar Jawaligi, Dean Faculty of Engineering & Technology (Co-Ed)Sharnbasva University, Kalaburagi
