Report on the IPR Workshop

An Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) workshop was organized on 16th July 2023 at Doddappa Appa Sabha Mantap, Sharnbasva University. The workshop was jointly conducted by the Departments of Studies and Research in English, Kannada, Journalism and Mass Communication, and Computer Applications of Sharnbasva University.
