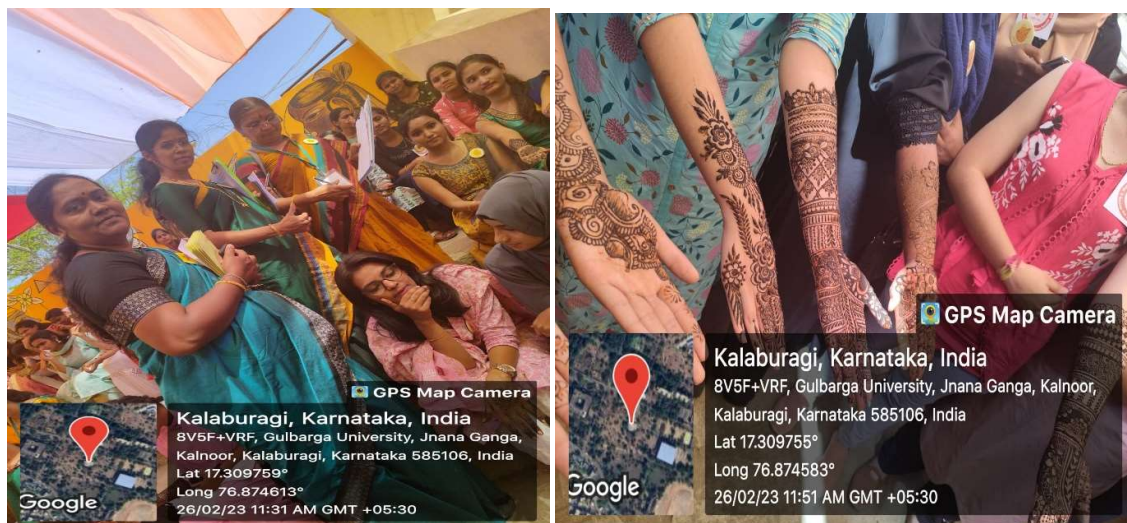
### EVENT 3: Mehandi Competition in collaboration with Kalyan Karnataka Mahila Utsava 2023

Digital Image Processing means processing digital image by means of a digital computer. We can also say that it is a use of computer algorithms, in order to get enhanced image either to extract some useful information.

Digital image processing is the use of algorithms and mathematical models to process and analyze digital images. The goal of digital image processing is to enhance the quality of images, extract meaningful information from images, and automate image-based tasks.



The basic steps involved in digital image processing are:

1. Image acquisition: This involves capturing an image using a digital camera or scanner, or importing an existing image into a computer.
2. Image enhancement: This involves improving the visual quality of an image, such as increasing contrast, reducing noise, and removing artifacts.
3. Image restoration: This involves removing degradation from an image, such as blurring, noise, and distortion.
4. Image segmentation: This involves dividing an image into regions or segments, each of which corresponds to a specific object or feature in the image.
5. Image representation and description: This involves representing an image in a way that can be analysed and manipulated by a computer, and describing the features of an image in a compact and meaningful way.

Design patterns provide general solutions or a flexible way to solve common design problems. This article introduces design patterns and how design patterns are implemented in C# and .NET.

Before starting with design patterns in .NET, let's understand the meaning of design patterns and why they are useful in software architecture and programming.

What are Design Patterns in Software Development?



Design Patterns in the object-oriented world are a reusable solution to common software design problems that repeatedly occur in real-world application development. It is a template or description of how to solve problems that can be used in many situations.

*"A pattern is a recurring solution to a problem in a context."*

*"Each pattern describes a problem that occurs over and over again in our environment and then describes the core of the solution to that problem in such a way that you can use this solution a million times over without ever doing it the same way twice." - Christopher Alexander, A Pattern Language.*

Developers use patterns for their specific designs to solve their problems. Pattern choice and usage among various design patterns depend on individual needs and concerns. Design patterns are a very powerful tool for software developers. It is important to understand design patterns rather than memorizing their classes, methods, and properties. Learning how to apply patterns to specific problems is also important to get the desired result. This will require continuous practice using and applying design patterns in software development. First, identify the software design problem, then see how to address these problems using design patterns and determine the best-suited design problem to solve the problem.

**Students got knowledge on C# concepts and Realtime usage of software development and gained knowledge about the design patterns.**

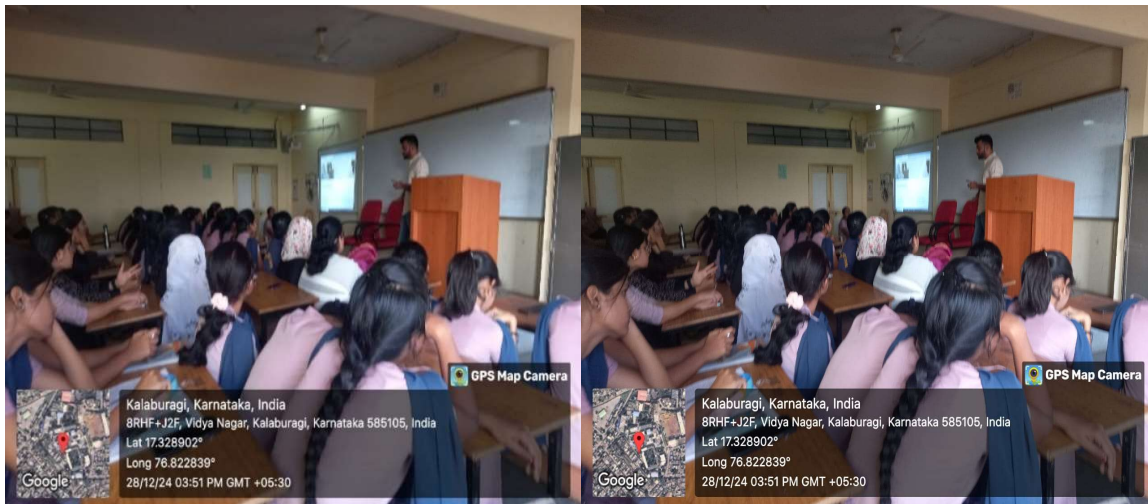
## EVENT 21: Career Guidance

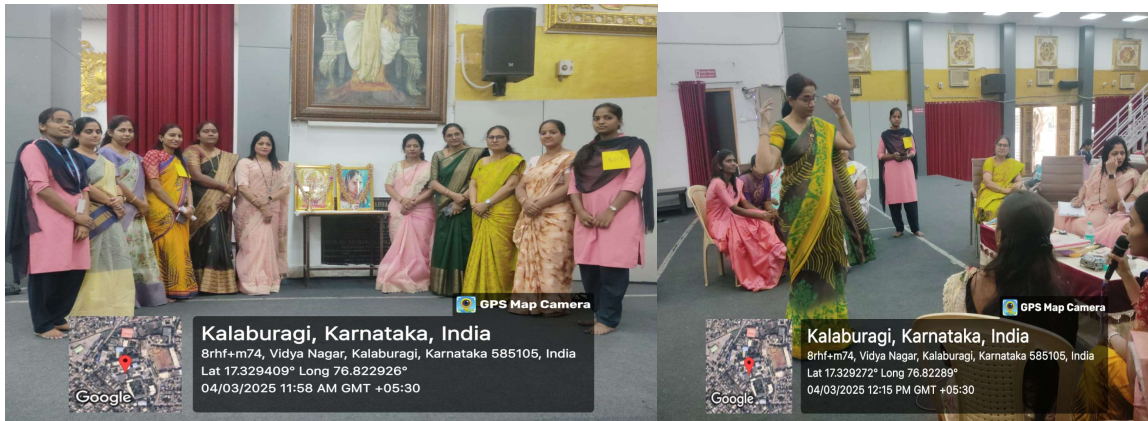
## EVENT 25: Antakshari Competition

The event was fun and enjoyable for the participants and for the organisers

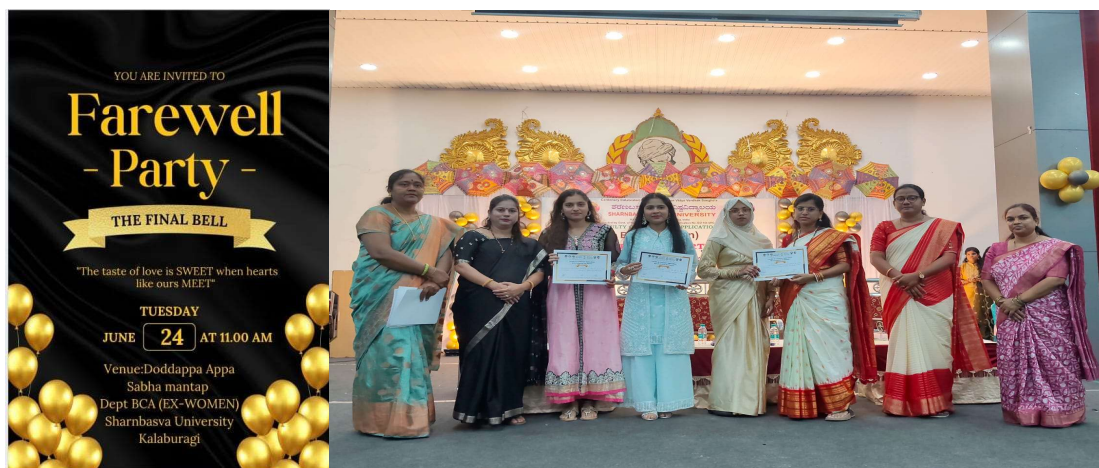


## EVENT 26: “The Final Bell!” Farewell Party

## EVENT 29: A keynote talk on “Detecting Brain Cancer in Early Stages by using Machine Learning “

The Department of BCA (Exclusively for Women) organized a keynote talk on “Detecting Brain Cancer in Early Stages Using Machine Learning” as part of the **2nd International Conference on Integrated Intelligence and Communication Systems (ICIIS)–2024**, held on **23rd November 2023**. The keynote speaker was **Dr. Yen-Wei Chen** from the **College of Information Science and Engineering, Ritsumeikan University, Japan**.

Brain cancer is one of the most challenging diseases to diagnose in its early stages due to subtle and complex symptoms. Recent advancements in **Machine Learning (ML)** have opened new frontiers in medical diagnostics, especially in the field of early cancer detection. Machine Learning algorithms can analyze medical images such as MRIs and CT scans to detect abnormal patterns, often with higher accuracy and speed than traditional diagnostic methods.

This keynote talk focused on how intelligent systems are being developed to support early and more accurate detection of brain tumours, reducing the burden on radiologists and improving patient outcomes. By training models on large datasets, ML can identify even minute signs of malignancy that may be missed by the human eye.

The session, delivered by **Dr. Yen-Wei Chen**, an expert from **Ritsumeikan University, Japan**, highlighted state-of-the-art research, clinical applications, and future challenges in integrating AI tools into the healthcare ecosystem.
