Brief Report including above information	The Regional Hackathon, jointly organized by the JN GERBI Foundation, Bidar, and Sharnbasva University, Kalaburagi, was held on 1st August 2024. The event aimed to bring together students from various institutions to present and develop innovative solutions to pressing challenges. It attracted significant participation from both students and staff, showcasing a diverse array of ideas and projects. Registration: The event began with registration at 9:30 AM, allowing participants to sign in and form teams. Student Presentations: The initial student presentations started promptly at 10:00 AM, where teams began showcasing their preliminary ideas and solutions. Official Inauguration: The official inauguration ceremony commenced at 11:30 AM, with the presence of key dignitaries including the Chief Guest, the Dean of Sharnbasva University, and other notable guests. The inauguration featured speeches highlighting the importance of innovation and collaboration. Lunch Break: Following the inauguration, a lunch break was provided for participants to network and discuss their ideas informally. Continued Presentations: After lunch, presentations resumed, giving teams the opportunity to refine and pitch their ideas further. Over 150 students engaged actively in the hackathon, representing multiple departments and colleges, with 50 staff members providing guidance and support. Students from a variety of sectors submitted 86 concepts during pitch sessions. These ideas were multidisciplinary and encompassed a vast range of expertise and understanding. The program included interactive sessions in which participants received feedback from mentors and judges to enhance the quality of their presentations and solutions. The event demonstrated how teamwork fosters student creativity and helps to resolve community problems.
